



How to get to...

The EATA 2023 Conference venue from the Gdańsk Lech Wałęsa Airport:

To reach the EATA 2023 Conference venue by **public transportation (bus + tram)** it is most convenient to use bus line no. 110 from the airport (B-point on the location map), then change to tram no. 5, 6, 9 or 12 at “Galeria Bałtycka” stop (D-point on the location map), get off at “Politechnika” stop (F-point on the location map) and reach the Main Building of Gdansk University of Technology (A-point on the location map) after a short walk. **Approximate travel time is 50 min.**

The EATA 2023 Conference venue from the Gdańsk Główny (Gdańsk Central) railway station:

Direct connection between Gdańsk Główny railway station and Gdańsk University of Technology is available. It is most convenient to get on tram no. 2, 3, 6 or 9 at “Dworzec Główny” stop (C-point on the location map), get off at the “Opera Bałtycka” stop (E-point on the location map) and reach the Main Building of Gdańsk University of Technology (A-point on the location map) after a short walk through the campus park. **Approximate travel time is 20 min.**

The centre of Gdańsk (old town) from the Gdańsk Lech Wałęsa Airport:

Direct connection between the airport and the centre of Gdansk is available. It is most convenient to get on bus no. 210 at the airport (B-point on the location map) and get off at the “Dworzec Główny” stop (C-point on the location map). **Approximate travel time is 35 min.**

From there, various trams and busses can be used to reach your destination, as explained above.

Travelling through Gdańsk and Tri-City

You can plan your travels in Gdańsk and Tri-City with the help of this very convenient planner:

Public transportation in Gdańsk requires using tickets available at ticket machines which are available both at the airport (B-point on the location map) and the “Dworzec Główny” stop in Gdańsk city center (C-point on the location map). You



need to validate your ticket in a validator immediately after entering a bus or a tram. You can choose:

- **a normal 1-ride ticket** (traveling with no time limitations, but using only one line)
– ticket for 3,80 PLN
- **a normal 1-hour ticket** (traveling for 1 hour and no line limitations)
– ticket for 4,40 PLN.
- **a normal 24-hour ticket** (traveling for 24 hours, no line limitations)
– ticket for 14,00 PLN.

Please note, that Sopot, Gdynia and Gdańsk use different ticket tariffications and if you wish to journey through different parts of Tri-City you may purchase a metropolitan ticket which is valid in all means of public transportation available – busses, trams and SKM trains.
